This year two churches were constructed and dedicated in Haiti. While these churches proclaim the gospel, they also have become education and training centers for the community. The church of Cabo is meets the need of the farming community which is located two hours outside of of Port-au-Prince. The Church of Silo, constructed on a hilly mountain side in memory of Linda Steiner, serves near the epicenter of the 2010 earthquake and restores hope for the devastated region. TMBC BIBLE CURRICULUM LAUNCHED

The Mini Bible College (TMBC) was met with overwhelming response at the Introduction Pastors Meeting in Port Salut. Area pastors stated they were looking for a structured curriculum to train their leaders and congregation. The TMBC curriculum, provided by International Cooperating Ministries (ICM), meets this desire to teach the local church and further the training of those called into ministry. TMBC offers a two year bible based curriculum that has been translated into Creole, in audio and written formats to meet the needs of Haitian pastors.

The three day clinic provided medical relief for the poor constituents of Leogane and outlying rural areas. Volunteer physicians and medical staff from the US treated over 1,000 patients in three days with donated medicine and supplies.
